Scholarship Application Process

1. Wood Badge Course Application must be completed, signed by the Scout Executive and submitted.
2. Registration fee for the Wood Badge course must be paid before the registration deadline.
3. The application for scholarship must be fully completed and submitted before the course registration deadline.
4. The applicant will be notified of the scholarship amount offered within two weeks of the application review.
5. The applicant has one week (7 days) from the date the scholarship is offered to accept the scholarship offered or withdraw from the course. The applicant is entitled to a full refund of fees paid if the scholarship is inadequate to resolve the financial hardship.
